**Project target and planned results:** The aim of the Project focuses on strengthening of cooperation between scientific circles of MUG with regional and national enterprises and institutions and radical change of approach to practical aspects of research conduct, with special attention given to medical research.

This goal will be reached by establishing of the first regional network of medical, pharmaceutical and biotechnological knowledge and technology transfer between GMU, both technological parks involved and innovation oriented enterprises. The Project will help to construct the first data base on research and know-how potential of GMU and will encourage its active promotion. A Business Point, promoting cooperation with local entities will be opened at GMU, while 2 Science Points will be opened at both Technological Parks (in Gdynia and in Gdańsk respectively), promoting cooperation with medical circles.

The Project delivers intensive training schedule for GMU workers, Ph.D. students and students, focusing on various aspects of economic activity and also numerous task-oriented meetings for seven research GMU groups with chosen experts. In the longer period the Project should enable the society to obtain new technological and analytical solutions and clinical procedures, implemented into practice by pharmaceutical, cosmetic and food processing companies and medical
